SHARED SERVICES is an operational philosophy that enables school districts to gain efficiencies by strategically centralizing, consolidating and standardizing non-classroom functions. The broader objective is to gain efficiencies beyond consolidation through a methodology of continuous improvement and standardized processes that rely on automation/enablement of technology. The shared services model is built on three primary capability levers: people, process, and technology.

What are some of the primary benefits of a shared services model?

- Economies of Scale Lower costs
- Standardization of Processes Best practices and compliance
- Common Technology Platforms Enables coordinated transformation of back offices
- Culture People with the skill and mindset to optimize the model beyond the back office
- Operations Experts School administrators free to focus on the education of students.
- Automation of Routine Tasks School staff are free to focus on strategy – rely on Shared Services for statutory compliance, controls, and information
- Decision Support Data analyzed and delivered as reliable and actionable information
- Redundancy Shared Services team remediates district staff issues often created by absences and turnover.
- Scalability The shared services delivery model can be scaled with relatively low incremental costs.
- Expanded Knowledge Base Districts have access to a wider scope of resources and information.

The Allegheny Intermediate Unit's (AIU) Shared Services model delivers results by consolidating, standardizing, and automating common processes performed by school districts. The model provides economies of scale (lower costs), remediates personnel staffing risks, increases district capacity, and advances student-facing initiatives that promote student achievement.
